### AV AND VRWC CHAMPIONSHIPS, MIDDLE PARK, SUNDAY 7 AUGUST 2011

Conditions were perfect for the 73 walkers who raced in the annual AV and VRWC Roadwalking Championships at Middle Park on Sunday morning. The first events to kick off at 8:30AM were the Victorian 30km championship along with a VRWC 3 Hour walk. Disappointingly, the 30km saw only one starter in Simon Evans of Box Hill but he was up to the task, finishing in 2:54:59 to claim his first ever Victorian championship. We were also pleased to see so many club walkers start and finish the 3 hour walk. Liz Feldman was our top female finisher with 26.113km while Simon kept on the track for the extra few minutes to record 30.728km as the best male.

The next events to start were the 10km events at 9AM. Unfortunately, we became aware later in the morning that one of the turns had been incorrectly laid out and that, as a consequence, the 2km lap was 39m under distance. This meant that the 10km walks were 195m under distance. While this made no difference to the overall result, it does mean that the finish times were inaccurate. I have calculated an adjusted 10km time for each competitor for completeness. We are most disappointed that this happened and apologise to the walkers whose times were effected. There were a number of excellent walks from the likes of Kelly Ruddick and Beth Alexander and others. Victorian champions were Lucas Taylor, Beth Alexander and Jared Walker (in the tightest of finishes over Aaron Tam).

## RWV RETAINS RWA STATE CHALLENGE

All clubs have now submitted their Racewalking Australia State Challenge results and Mark Donahoo has done the necessary calculations. The final result sees Racewalking Victoria win ahead of the Tasmanian Racewalking Club with the Western Australian Race Walking Club third. As per current practice, Mark applies a fairness calculation to even up the competition and give smaller clubs more of a chance. The scores for clubs of 40 or fewer members (as submitted to the RWA AGM) have their score divided by 1.6, clubs with 41-80 members have their score divided by 1.3 and clubs with over 80 members are left unaltered. The challenge is won by the club with the smallest overall total.

### AA SELECTION POLICY FOR THE 2012 WORLD RACE WALKING CHAMPIONSHIPS

Athletics Australia has now released the Selection Document for the 2012 World Race Walking Cup, to be held in Saransk in May next year. See [http://www.athletics.com.au/high\\_performance/high\\_performance\\_news/team\\_information/2012wwc/selection\\_policy](http://www.athletics.com.au/high_performance/high_performance_news/team_information/2012wwc/selection_policy)  
Salient points are as follows:

There will be Selection Trials for each event at the IAAF 2012 World Race Walking Cup. Those Trials are:

- Men's 50km Walk – the 2011 Australian 50km Walk Championship, Fawkner Park, Melbourne, **Sunday 11 Dec 2011.**
- Men's and Women's 20km Walk – 2012 Australian 20km Walk Championships Hobart, Tasmania, **Saturday 25 Feb 2012.**
- Junior Men's and Women's 10km Walk – to be conducted as invitation events at the 2012 Australian 20km Walk Championship, Hobart, Tasmania, **Saturday 25 Feb 2012.**

Selection Standards are as follows	20km Men	1.28.00

The Selection Standards above must be achieved within the selection periods which are as follows:

- For Senior Men and Women - between 01 August 2011 and the date of the relevant Selection Trial (11 December 2011 for the 50km Walk, 25 February 2012 for all other Events).
- For Junior Men and Women – between 01 August 2011 and 25 February 2012.

#### Automatic Selection

- Men's 50km Event  
Any athlete selected to represent Australia at the 2011 IAAF World Championships in athletics in Daegu may automatically nominate for selection in the 50km event. For the purposes of clarity, there is no right of automatic selection by virtue of performance at the Selection Trial and there is no Athletics Australia Selection Standard.
- Men's and Women's 20km Event  
The first three (3) eligible athletes in the Selection Trial (both men and women) will be automatically selected in the Team provided that the athlete has achieved the performance standard within Athletic Australia's Qualifying Period.
- Junior Men's and Junior Women's 10km Event  
The first three (3) place getters at the Selection Trial in both Junior Men's and Junior Women's Event will be automatically selected in the Team provided those athletes have achieved the qualifying time within the Athletics Australia's qualifying period.

A few personal comments;

- The selection criteria are potentially cut-throat for our Junior walkers. The maximum team size is 3 and, if the first 3 at the trial have qualifiers, they will be selected. So a non appearance at the trial or a bad race or a DQ could see you miss out. So be prepared to walk well in the trial!
- The 2012 Australian 20km championship date has now been confirmed for Hobart on the evening of Saturday 25 February. I believe that this is also likely to be the Olympic trial.
- Although the selection period is short, there are potentially plenty of walk opportunities on offer. The main local ones are

Sunday 21 August Australian Roadwalking Championships in Canberra (20km and 10km)  
 Sunday 11 December Australian 50km championship and associated 20km Open and 10km Junior events

There are also potentially other 20km/10km qualifying opportunities during the summer - for instance, VRWC will be scheduling Sunday morning carnivals in October and November and we can potentially get them ratified by AA if we think people are intending to use them to gain qualifying times. Obviously the more notice we get, the better! Our draft summer fixture has these two dates set as

Sun 23 Oct 2011 VRWC Roadwalks, Middle Park  
 Sun 13 Nov 2011 VRWC Road Championships and AGM, Middle Park
